

9 Drama Rehearsal Routine

Warm up - vocal and physical

- This is teacher directed and will go up to 5 minutes.

Team handshake

- 1 minute: I will count in and your cast will do their 'handshake' and go straight into rehearsal time.

Rehearsal time:

- 5 -10 minutes: Line run-through and dedicated time to memorise lines.
- 1 minute: Setting up audience and stage:
 - Set up stage using chairs and relevant items to help you with your moving on stage.
 - Decide where your audience will be by place a chair there. This helps you be visually aware of where you are on stage.
- Run through your scene, stopping and restarting as you need. This could include:
 - Filming your performance and watching back taking note of what you are doing on stage and what needs to be fixed.
 - Getting another group to watch and give feedback based on specific things you are looking for.
 - Running through a specific section of the scene again to ensure it is strongly and confidently presented.
 - Practice the vocal delivery of the lines ensuring you are performing as a character and not yourself. There are resources on the wall near the phone.

Reflection time:

- 5 minutes: Answering emailed questions truthfully ensuring everyone is included in the response so they are all in the loop of what's happening.
- Please be aware that as time goes on, it will be obvious if you are implementing feedback and using rehearsal time well.

Drama games (if there's time): Directed by the teacher.
